Re: Rule changes – 2003 Driving Season

BMW CCA National invited Driver School Event Chairman and Chief Instructors from every Chapter to attend a Driving Events Conference in Atlanta, GA on February 22nd and 23rd where the Driver School Minimum Standards were updated and various related topics were discussed in an open forum.

The following changes are being implemented with the Delaware Valley Chapter Driver School program as a result of decisions that were made at this conference.

- Beginning with our Driving Events this season, the event application requires the participants signature to acknowledge that he/she has read, understands and agrees to be bound by the event release and waiver form. The release and waiver form can be printed and or read by visiting the Chapter's Website; www.delvalbmwcca.org
- No one under the age of 18 will be permitted to participate as a Student, accept a ride with an Instructor or be granted access to the "Restricted Areas" at a Delaware Valley Chapter Driver School. The "Restricted Areas" consist of but are not limited to the following:
 - a) The Track Surface
 - b) Flag Stations
 - c) The Control Tower
 - d) The Hot Pits
- No Student may be pre-signed off for an event. BMW CCA's Chapters do not have access to the Club's event insurance for lapping day events.

The Delaware Valley Chapter remains dedicated to it's goal of providing educational driving events that are safe and fun to attend for all participants. Our primary focus, however, will always be placed on safety.
